- Recipients of regular customer audits against the Gangmaster Licencing Act (GLA) standards.
- Receipts of regular third party Ethical Trading Initiative (ETI) audits to SEDEX Members Ethical Trading Audit (SMETA) standards.
- Training for employees via the Stronger2gether campaign, a multi stakeholder initiative which aims
 to reduce human trafficking, forced, bonded or indentured labour and any other hidden "third party"
 exploitation of workers.
- Clear written and communicated policies on Ethical Trading and Preventing Hidden Labour Exploitation.

We will ensure, where appropriate, that colleagues will attend related seminars and workshops to ensure we are kept up to date with new developments and best practice.

One Call Recruitment will never knowingly enter into a business relationship with any organisation involved with slavery or human trafficking. The Directors of the company accept responsibility for the implementation of any policy in relation to this matter and for the provision of adequate resources (training etc.) to ensure that slavery or human trafficking is not taking place in the company or its supply chain.

This statement has been approved by the Directors of One Call Recruitment and will be reviewed annually.
